Welcome / Set Up

Sign in sheet. Music. Snacks.

Game 1 - Down/Up

Students stand in a circle facing each other. The leader says down, and everyone looks down, the leader say up and each student looks up at another student. If students make eye contact they are both out. Last one or two standing win.

Game 2 - 3,6,9 Clap

Form a circle. Everyone counts. Any number that contains a 3,6,or 9 must not be said but instead must clap. Example: 1, 2, clap ,4, 5, clap, 7, 8, clap...28, clap, clap, clap, clap...Students have one second to go, or else they are out, so they must pay attention and must know how to count.

Topic Intro - Trust

How many here can say “it’s easy for me to trust others”?

“How many here struggle to trust others?”

I’ve had my fair share of trust issues that’s for sure. (personal story: 8th grade friend)

Afterwards it hurt, it took some time but overtime. I continued to show interest and care. I was able to establish a friendship again. It wasn’t easy, it took time. But when you do your part to rebuild , trust can happen again. You gotta be present and you gotta be authentic.
